



liberty street residence hall (coed)



This co-ed complex houses 420 students in two-person rooms. There is a small study area in the front of the room and two bedrooms are connected by a bathroom that four residents share.

The color scheme for Liberty rooms: bright white walls, ceilings, and baseboards, tan tile flooring and full-spectrum “daylight quality” lighting. Desk, floor or table lamps will help brighten the area, but no halogen lamps are allowed. Students may bring their own area rugs (a standard 3’x5’ rug easily fits in the aisle between the beds; a 5’x8’ rug fits when the edges are under the bed). Each room is furnished with a micro-fridge (which is a microwave and refrigerator combination). No additional refrigerators or microwaves are allowed.



In each room there is a vanity area that contains one sink, under-the-counter storage and four drawers. The vanity counter tops are gun-metal gray with a black-and-white boomerang pattern. The cabinets are bright white. In the shared bathroom area there is a shower (48” wide x 30” deep) and a toilet. Residence life does provide a plain white vinyl shower curtain, but you may bring your own. There is no storage space in the bathroom area, so for additional storage residents may bring over-the-toilet cabinets that are supported by poles; wall attachments are not allowed.



There are two, two-level community rooms used for socializing. On the second level of the community room is a home theater with a balcony that overlooks an open space with lounge seating. On the other side of the lounge is a game room with vending machines, a pool table, and a foosball table. There are laundry rooms on the first, third, and fifth floors. They come with washers, dryers, and tables where residents can study. In addition to the large community rooms, the building has one or two study rooms with conference-style seating on each floor. These can be used for group or individual study sessions.

The Liberty Street Fresh Food Company (the College’s dining hall) is located on the ground floor of this building. In addition, the residence hall has a multi-zone fire alarm system, fire sprinkler system, digital security camera system and 24-hour information/security desk.

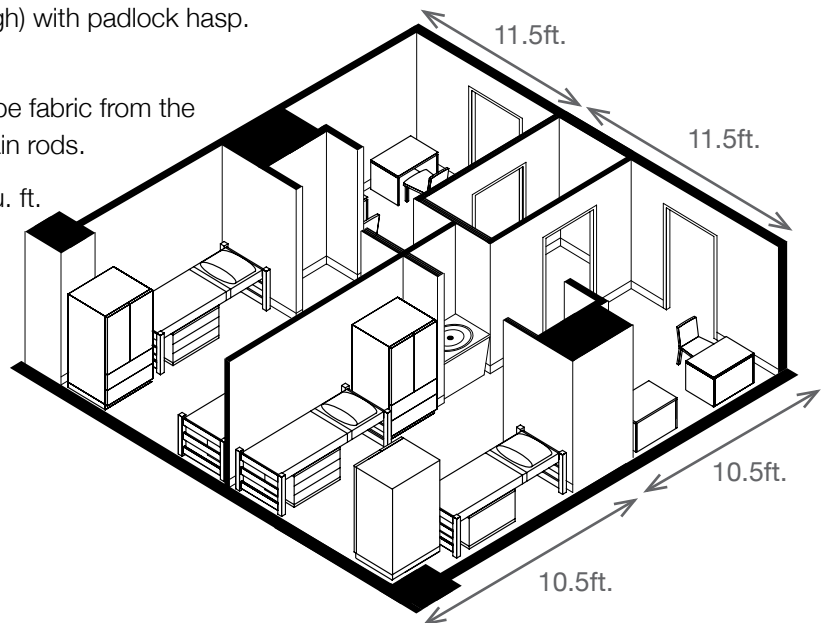
“I play ping pong, and the communal area is great for that. We also have nice study rooms, which are good for private time or meetings.

liberty street residence hall bedrooms

- Two wood-frame cherry-finish beds (80"x36") loftable* and bunkable – twin-long sheets
* gives approximately 66" of vertical clearance under the bed at full loft position and approximately 30 inches of vertical clearance under the bed at the semi-loft position
- Two cherry-finish desks (42" wide x 24" deep x 30" high) with retractable keyboard and mouse surface with rear storage, retractable reference shelf and three storage drawers.
- Two cherry wood-frame desk chairs with a navy blue upholstered seat
- Two cherry-finish chests of drawers (36" wide x 24" deep x 30" high). They are designed to align perfectly with the desks to create a 78" continuous work surface under the lofted bed assembly.
- Two wardrobe cabinets (36" wide x 24" deep x 60" high) with padlock hasp.
*Note: There is no drawer space in the wardrobe cabinets.
- Window covered by 1" mini-blinds. Students may drape fabric from the valance but may not use wall- or frame-fastened curtain rods.
- One small microwave and compact refrigerator (3.6 cu. ft. interior capacity)
- Air conditioning
- Telephone hook-up (per bedroom)
- Basic cable television service (per bedroom)
- "Wired" Internet service (per student)
